



## Kelly Marks - BHS TREC Winter Series 09/10



### Schedule & Entry Form

In 2005 /2006 the BHS introduced an exciting new development with a programme of Winter BHS TREC competitions, focussing on the Control of Paces and PTV obstacle phases. The series will run again this Winter across the UK.

There are two classes - **Newcomers** and **Open**. **To be eligible for Newcomers, riders must not have taken part in more than one full BHS TREC competition (ie all three phases) and must not have won a Winter Series Open/Newcomers class before 1<sup>st</sup> October 2009.** The Open class is open to all. At each event, the winner of each class will receive a signed Kelly Marks book and special rosettes from first to sixth place will be awarded. **Newcomers may also enter the Open Class.** Any competitors entering the Open must do the Open round before any other. **Open competitors may pay for a second round 'HC'.** Times will be given approx 20 mins apart if doing 2 rounds.

Each competitor's score will be converted to a percentage achieved. A Rankings table of the best percentages for a) **Newcomers** and b) **Open** will be maintained, and published on the BHS website. The overall winner in each section (individual top percentage score) will receive a trophy from the BHS and the Top 10 placed riders will receive prizes, at the end of the series.

### What will I have to do?

There will be three parts to the competition. These are the two Control of Paces sections - a) Canter and b) Walk and the PTV obstacle phase.

### Control of Paces

When it's your turn, you will canter as slowly as possible along a measured track (usually around the outside of the arena), and then walk the same distance as fast as possible. The *slower* you canter and *faster* you walk, the more points you'll get.

### PTV Obstacle Phase

Ten straightforward obstacles, simulated to represent those you might meet out hacking, to test riding skills, and the training and handiness of your horse or pony. Suitable for ALL levels of rider, and every kind of horse or pony, these might include a footbridge, bending, leading, a small jump, mounting, opening and closing a gate, rein-back, ducking under low branches, an S-bend, riding through a corridor of poles on the ground. Examples can be found in the [BHS TREC Rulebook](#), and some obstacles will be adapted for use in an arena. Rulebooks will be for sale at the competition for £5.95 each

### Rules

- *BHS TREC rules apply*
- *A hard hat to a minimum of PAS015, EN1384 or ASTM F1193 must be worn and fastened by all mounted riders, whether competing or not.*
- *Continuation after elimination in any class will be at the discretion of the Judge.*
- *No Dogs*
- *No smoking anywhere on the premises*
- *Please don't clear horse muck out in to the yard.*
- *Please be sensible – if your horse is showing signs of being unwell – stay away.*
- *Neither the organisers of this event nor any person acting on their behalf, the owners of the show ground or agents acting on their behalf, accept any liability for any loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.*
- *The organisers reserve the right to cancel, restrict, combine or split the classes according to entries. Where possible, notice will be given.*
- *No refund of entries*
